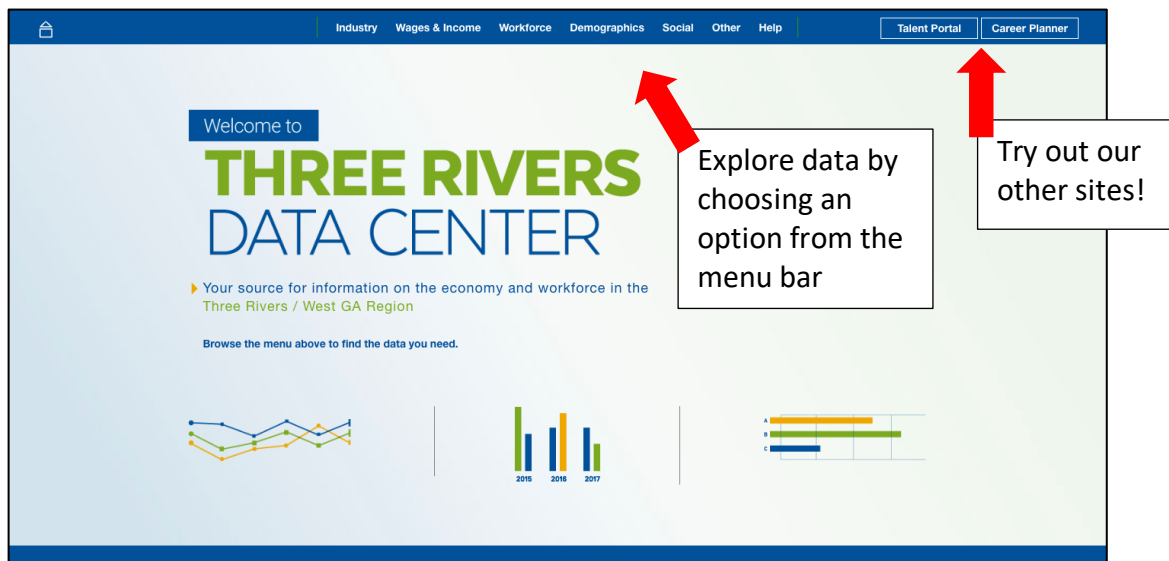

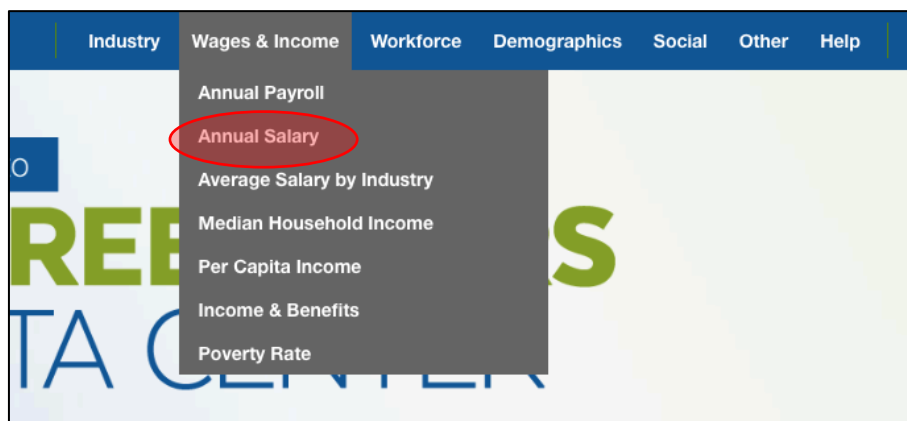
Homepage

- The **Career Planner** is a tool to help students and workers of all ages make informed decisions about their education and job choices in the region based on current, local data across all industries.

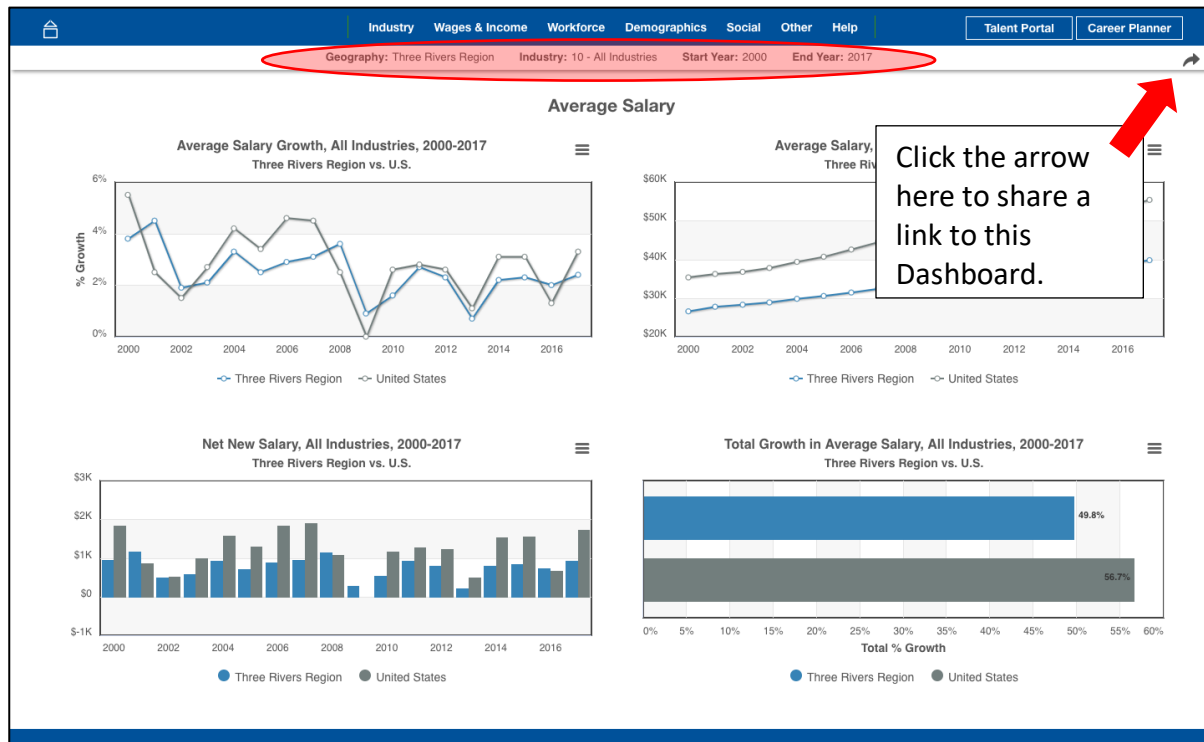


Let's try clicking into a data category to see how it works. Let's use "Annual Salary" for our example.

We call this page a Dashboard and each Dashboard will have a number of Graphs related to the data topic you choose. Below, you can see data for “Annual Salary” in the Region.



You can change the Graphs by using the **Filter bar**, underneath the menu bar, circled above and shown below. You can filter to look at a specific county, industry and change which years the data will display.

Click on the three lines (the “hamburger icon”) in the upper right-hand corner to see different options for downloading and to print the Graph. You can see those options below.

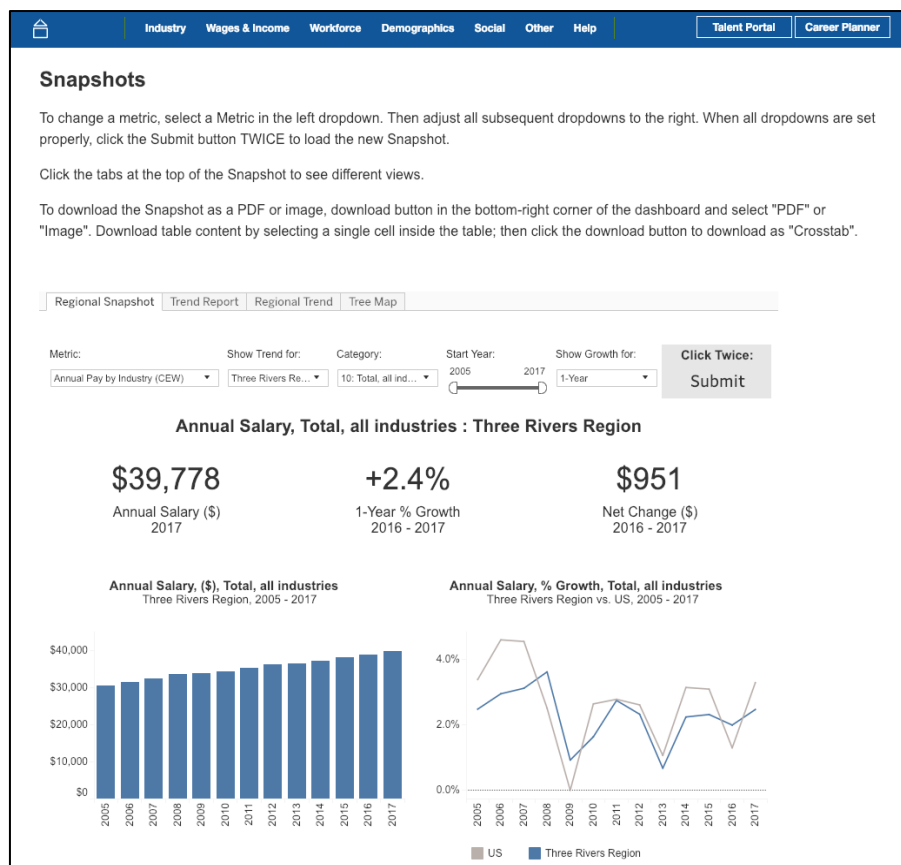

By choosing “Other” in the menu bar, you can access some special content.



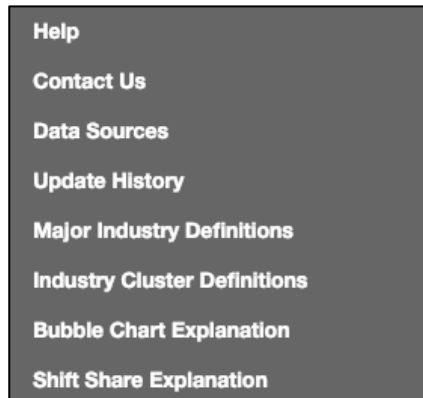
Snapshots will show downloadable one-page reports on various views of a metric. Set the filters at the top of the snapshot window and hit “Submit” twice to see more.
