YOUR PATH TO A MANUFACTURING CAREER STARTS EARLY

Georgia's Career Clusters allow students to choose an area of interest in high school from 17 possible clusters. Students classes tailored to their cluster, which helps them navigate their way to greater success – no matter what they choose to do after high school graduation.

- Come down and visit the cities of Jackson, Flovilla, Jenkinsburg, Indian Springs, Jackson Lake and all the other things to see and do here. Visit us, enjoy our green spaces and we think you'll see why Butts County is truly Georgia's Outdoor Capitol!
- Indian Springs State Park and High Falls State Park, offer camping, hiking, creek wading, mini-golf, boating, historical sites, cabin rentals, and large group activity venues. You can also visit Dauset Trails Nature Center, owned and operated by a non-profit charitable foundation as an animal and nature preserve, encompasses several hundred acres, complete with mountain bike and walking trails, rare wildlife, ponds and lakes, educational exhibits and more.
- Noted restaurants that draw people from across the state such as Buckner's, home to some of the south's best fried chicken, and Fresh Air Barbecue, the oldest barbecue restaurant in Georgia still in its original site.
- Camera-ready filming locations, including downtown Jackson, which is now the TV hometown in "Stranger Things", a new hit series by Netflix. Other venues which have been featured in film and television include the Carmichael House (featured in "The Originals") and Jackson Lake (featured in the movie "Endless Love").
- Active Community Civic Organizations that offer a variety of entertainment events throughout the year, including the Jackson Alive Fall Festival, Halloween on Second Street, Christmas in the City, the Native American Festival, Artifact Day at Indian Springs, Jenkinsburg Founders Day Festival, Flovilla Day Festival, Christmas in the Village, the Bluebirds and Bluegrass festival and much more.
